

## TOP TEN PERFORMANCE RULES

1. All performance statistics and awards for “Top Ten” shall be based on the calendar year. To be eligible for any AMCA sponsored annual award, trophy, certificate, etc., the recipient must be the owner of an Alaskan Malamute and an AMCA member-in-good-standing at the time the title is earned.

2. To be awarded points, a qualifying score must be earned. Points will be given to the Malamute based on the following chart of scores:

Master Agility class. Since points in the class will be awarded based solely on time, for the Master Class only, conversion of AKC speed points to award points will be according to the following chart:

<u>AKC Speed Points</u>	<u>AMCA Award Points</u>
0 - 4	1
5 - 8	2
9 – 12	3
13 – 16	4
17 – 20	5
21+	6

A bonus of three (3) points will be awarded in each tracked class any time double/triple qualifying scores at the same trial are earned in any levels of Agility, Rally, or the Open/Utility Obedience classes (update: to include Preferred Obedience classes). Additionally, a bonus of five (5) points will be awarded to any Malamute who is designated as High in Trial (HIT) at any all-breed obedience trial.
