## Committee Reports & Special Reports

### **AKC Delegate Report – December 2017 Delegate Meeting**

Due to Tex having major back surgery, these Delegate notes were sent to me by: Diane Frank, Delegate for the Langley Kennel Club and Diane Ramsey, Delegate for the Schipperke Club of America.

This meeting started with an hour of “training” on the relaunch of AKC.org. This relaunch of the website is expected to occur in January 2018. You will notice several changes to the website. First off: Branding. The branding of the website has been made to consistent with the offline materials, such as booklets, pamphlets, and flyers. The Search feature has been greatly improved. AKC doesn’t want its visitors to have to go to Google to search for content on their site. The Breed specific page has been reduced from three pages to one. It initially has a brief description of the breed, such as size, longevity, good with children/other dogs. Additional images have been added to the page. There is a separate

tab for the breed standard. The History and About sections were done by AKC staff and corrections or suggestions can be sent to the address below.

Rescue Tab – The relaunch of AKC.org has prompted suggestions to confirm that the rescue organizations listed on the Parent Club website are approved and supported by the Parent Club. It is up to the Parent Club to make sure this information is up to date. It is also implying that because it is taken from our website, that our Parent Club endorses or supports the listed organizations for the rescue of our breed. I believe this is a list that needs to be reviewed by the Board.

AKC Marketplace should be monitored by the Parent Club.

An email was sent out in May or June 2017 to the Parent Clubs about AKC Marketplace. It was suggested that the Parent Club monitor the AKC Marketplace website to confirm that there aren’t any false advertisements. It is also the Parent Club’s responsibility

to monitor the Breeder of Merit list and make adjustments if they are aware of any issues. These responsibilities need to be discussed by the Board to determine if they will be added to a current committee or a new committee to monitor the AKC website content will need to be formed.

Health statements are online. It is the Parent Club’s responsibility to confirm that this information is up to date.

Sheila Goffe spoke about Legislative issues. There were about 2,000 bills up in 2017. Legislative alerts were sent out on 115. Legislation related to Dog Groomers has doubled in the last year

She did advise that local bills are becoming more prominent because of AKC’s success at squashing bills at the state level. She advised of a Parent

Club Legislative Facebook page. They are going to continue the Legislative Conferences next year. She discussed the Grooming Support (AKC Safe Groomer), there is work going on with Bomb Detection Dogs and a discussion about non economical damages that are being claimed in legislation. The AKC Position statements on the above three topics are as follows:

#### **Canine Legislation Position Statement – Grooming**

*Appropriate grooming to ensure health and wellbeing is part of responsible dog ownership. The time an owner spends grooming a dog helps to build the bond between dog and owner. Health and safety should always be primary considerations when grooming a dog. In addition to other appropriate training, AKC recommends that professional groomers should pass a course and exam on basic health and safety standards, such as AKC Salon Safety or a similar program, prior to being licensed as a professional groomer. Grooming that is incidental to preparing a dog for a dog show or other exhibition should be conducted with similar care but should not be subject to licensing or professional grooming regulations.*

#### **Canine Legislation Position Statement – Working and Detection Dogs**

*The American Kennel Club values the contribution that working and detection dogs make to national security and the extraordinary role that these dogs play in protecting the peace and security of individuals, communities and nations against extremist threats. The AKC honors the breeders, trainers, and handlers of these dogs, and supports expanded scientific research and breeding programs to ensure that sufficient high quality domestically-bred dogs are available to ensure public safety and national security and that specialized care is provided to assure the wellbeing of these dogs.*

#### **Canine Legislation Position Statement – Civil Damages in Cases Involving Injury to Pets**

*The American Kennel Club supports the appropriate awarding of traditional economic damages in cases involving negligent injury to an animal. Together with criminal laws that prohibit animal*

*cruelty and dog fighting, and civil laws that address both intentional and negligent injury or death of an animal, traditional economic damage in cases involving the negligent injury or death to an animal helps create a stable legal system that promotes responsible animal ownership, deters animal abuse, and promotes innovative, affordable, and quality animal care.*

Sheila discussed Mandatory Spay and Neuter bills that are passing with an “exemption” for AKC People or for people that participate in AKC Events, yet these items are not defined in the legislation. The problem with this type of legislation is that the exemption can be removed down the road and usually can be removed undetected. Good legislation doesn’t need to have exemptions.

Mari-Beth O’Neill announced that there have been four new clubs approved as Parent clubs. These clubs represent FSS breeds trying to qualify for the Miscellaneous class or breeds that qualify for the Miscellaneous class and trying to qualify as a recognized breed.

Veterinary Outreach - They hosted sixteen (16) Lunch N Learns, with two (2) more planned in January.

Group Reassessment – They announced will have a comprehensive report in March 2018.

There was a discussion on the number of events a specialty club can host. Many parent clubs have Regional clubs, while some have divisions or regions within the Parent club. Regional clubs or local breed clubs have different rules from parent clubs. Regional or licensed breed club events can’t exceed two days, and there have been events with participation that exceeds the two days. Any events that fall outside of the current parameters will be reviewed on a case by case basis. Licensed clubs do need Parent Club approval of the date of the events.

Mark Dunn – AKC Staff did the next presentation. He advised that there is no ongoing discussion to change limited registration.

Official Meeting booklet “Promoting Your Club and Its Events”. It has 30 pages. The Delegate Advocacy and

Advancement Committee also handed out a CD “Your AKC Delegate Opens Doors”. The content on the CD includes learn how a Delegate can help your AKC Member Club share information and needs with the AKC and fellow Delegates. Understand what happens at quarterly AKC Delegate meetings. There is also a YouTube link: <http://bit.ly/YourAKCDelegate>

Ron Menaker is running unopposed for the 2019 Board of Director spot. The Candidates running for the 2022 Board of Directors had a question and answer session from 9-10:20 prior to the official meeting. In the Official Meeting each candidate (Robert Amen, Carl Ashby, James Dok, Jan Ritchie Gladstone, Christopher Sweetwood, Harold “Red” Tatro and Ann Wallin) spoke to the body for three minutes. The vote will be held at the March 2018 Meeting.

It was announced that the National Dog Show being held this weekend has received the largest entry ever, over 8,600 entries received.

#### **December 2017 Chairman’s Message**

As we near the end of our 133rd year as America’s strongest advocate for purebred dogs, it is a privilege to reflect on how much we have accomplished. The cornerstone of our mission, AKC Sports and Events are our link to the past, present and future. In 2017 we challenged ourselves to create a path to growth for Events. An extraordinary set of projects were set in motion this year to fortify and expand our events for the benefit of all dogs and exhibitors.

A retention strategy was developed to ensure that current exhibitors will have a lifetime of activities to enjoy with their dogs. To achieve it, we created ways to expand existing sports and encourage transitions into other types of events. The Conformation Puppy of Achievement pilot program, the first Retriever Field Trial National Derby Championship, two new classes in Rally and the introduction of FSS breeds into Junior Showmanship are just some of the opportunities we created to encourage exhibitors to “go deeper” into our sports. We also introduced an enhanced Juniors Recognition Program and Junior Versatility scholarships to celebrate and support the diverse accomplishments

of our 15 youngest constituents. Our new advanced levels of the Breeder of Merit program recognizes breeders' long-term commitment and honors their mentorship of puppy buyers. The new Achiever Dog pilot program and an email campaign to CGC graduates not only recognize versatility but also encourage exhibitors to try their hand at new events.

Attracting new participants to AKC events was also a focal point of the year's activities. Education, communication and innovation were the components we leveraged to build a foundation for growth. Five videos were produced to educate newcomers about our Sports, including dog shows, the Agility ACT class, CGC and STAR Puppy, Farm Dog and Rally. There is now an AKC Sports Facebook page that shares our stories with a broadening audience. We have been making significant improvements to the Event Search functions on AKC.org to make it easier for potential exhibitors to find events, classes and training. A geo-targeted email campaign to new dog registrants will build awareness about Specialty shows and plant the seeds of community that we so enjoy through our breeds. We also launched an email campaign expressly for first-time exhibitors to welcome them to

the sport and encourage continued participation.

Expanding our portfolio of events has been another means to increase and diversify our constituency, as first happened with Agility back in the nineteen-nineties. This year we introduced the AKC Tricks program and the new sport of AKC Scent Work, which are welcoming new dog owners to the wonderful and wide world of AKC. Scent Work outpaced expectations with five thousand entries in its very first month. Our Tricks program has already achieved more than fifteen thousand title applications, proving the value dog owners place on training that is fun and flexible. Notably, thirty percent of Tricks title holders are new to AKC Events. Reaching a new audience through innovative programs is the first step in engaging dog owners, opening their eyes to broader possibilities with their dogs, and inspiring them to challenge themselves further.

Clubs are the lifeblood of our Sports and Events, so in 2017 we put new infrastructure in place to provide them with even greater support. We launched the Club Development Program to help clubs needing extra assistance to manage their shows and to devise strategies for growth. As a result of

working with this new department, several clubs have seen a notable increase in entries. Offering a helping hand and proving our commitment to quality and integrity are the most important ways in which AKC can make a difference for our Sports. Revisions to the judging approval process that emphasize breed education have been approved and will become effective in January; we hope the end result will be more qualified judges, more confident exhibitors, more successful shows and happier host clubs. We are already seeing the positive effects of this approach. Participation in the National Owner Handled Series has grown to cover nearly seventy percent of all breed shows, thanks in part to our strengthening of judging requirements for NOHS in 2017.

Improving the overall experience for current exhibitors and drawing in new participants with innovative programs are key objectives as we continue to foster the health and growth of AKC Events. Our focus over the past year will only sharpen as we head into a new year and a new season of exciting and rewarding events to share with our purebred dogs.

Happy New Year everyone! I hope you all had a very Merry Christmas and that you are looking forward to an exciting 2018. Not too many folks sent me anything for this issue, but what I got is great. Jen Effler Levelle. . . take it away:

“At the Western Waukesha County Dog Training Club the day after Thanksgiving, I took BUMPER (Masters level) and COPPER, **Powderhound's U Can't Handle The Truth WWPDA WPD WTD RN**, (Novice level). We had two trials that day. This was our first foray into the new Masters class and we weren't sure what to expect. We

weren't alone: the class was sizeable and everyone was nervous, including the judges, I think, because this was their first time judging it. In our first trial, BUMPER earned a 95, which was good enough for second place. Woo hoo! In his second, he earned a 92 and that was good enough for fourth place. I was pleased. COPPER was in Novice hoping to finish out his Rally Novice title. Well, he did, second place in a large class with a score of 94. Not only did that earn his title, his score was good enough to qualify him for the AKC Rally National Championship this summer! COPPER is the SIXTH dog of my breeding to earn this honor and if we make the draw, we're going to go. I have only gone once (last year) but it's an honor even qualifying. In the afternoon, I bumped him up to Advanced (because why not?) and I was a little nervous because it was off lead. He is my clown and will sometimes offers behaviors I didn't really ask for. Or he will be “overly joyful”. No worries. He had a good time but not TOO good

of a time and Mr. Consistency again got a score of 94, which was good enough for fourth place. A couple weeks later, BUMPER, and I headed down to the Christmas Cluster. The Masters class was not very big but the judging was tougher but not totally unfair. Three days, three trials, three Qs: a 97 for second place, an 80 for first place (yeah, ouch), and an 89 for first place. On the last two days we were the ONLY qualifiers. Yep, that bears repeating, the Malamute was the only survivor. Also that weekend, IVY, **RO1 AG1 Amaqut On The Pull WWDPX WTD WPD RE NAP OJP NFP CGCU TKN VAM AAAAM**, was WB/BOS for another two points. The weekend after that, we headed to Oshkosh Kennel Club. We had one moment in the ring of me thinking “Oh God, please don't you dare be the “malamute” they expect!! but he got it together. I don't remember BUMPER's score but it was good enough for second place in again, a large class.

"Between trials, we weight pulled. Normally I don't mention it because we participate in so many but this one bears mentioning. LUCY, **RO2 U-CH Powderhound's Blaze of Glory WWPDX WTD WPD RE CGCA CGCU VAM AAAM ROM-WDX\***, at 9.5 years of age, came in second in a class of 24 on time--the owner of the first place dog and I came to a 'truce' and decided both dogs had REALLY done enough, so we ended it on a good note. No big deal except she pulled 3,170# to do it, 39 x.625 her body weight. She's pulled more before at easier venue, but this was the first time breaching 3,000# with AMCW. I'm beyond proud of her, she has tremendous heart.

"In the last two days of 2017, BUMPER and I competed at the Cudahy KC rally trials. The first day he picked up leg #7 "with a first placement and a perfect score of 100! Day two we were less brilliant, but still picked up Masters Q #8 and a fourth placement. When we returned home that day, in the mailbox was a certificate from AKC honoring IVY as an Achiever Dog. What a nice surprise.

"On a personal note, ROWDY, **GCHB ThunderKloud's I'm No Secret**, and I ventured out to the AMCA Specialty held in conjunction with the Skokie Valley Kennel Club Show on December 9. Since it looks like we won't be showing for the foreseeable future, I wanted to get my handsome guy out one last time. He was entered in both Veteran Sweeps and Best of Breed and he had a blast. He danced, pranced, kissed kids and begged for treats. He was awarded BOS in Veteran Sweeps and got a nice look from the breed judge so it was a good day Thank you all for the nice compliments on ROWDY who will be 10 in April."

Ed: This is absolutely fabulous achievement for Jen and her dogs.

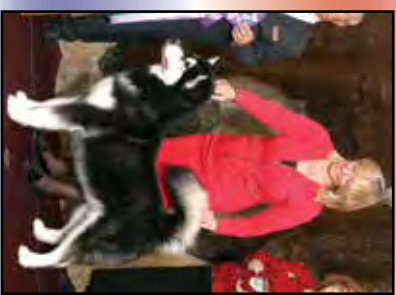

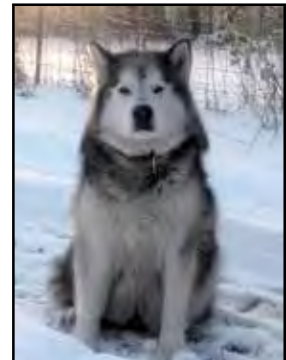

# National Specialty Judge Critique

## Mr. Larry Chu

It was indeed an honor to judge the 2017 Alaskan Malamute Club of American National Specialty in Huron, Ohio this past October. Many thanks to all that voted for me and to everyone that entered and supported this year's specialty. As a former breeder, exhibitor, and a current judge, this was the highlight of my 41 years in our breed, and most certainly a judge's dream in the sport of dog showing. There were many fine Alaskan Malamutes exhibited, making my job even more pleasing, yet challenging at the same time. Below are my comments regarding the winners selected, out of a tremendously nice entry.



### **Best In Specialty Show: GCH Onan House of the Rising Sun (D)**

An excellent example of our breed, comprising a beautiful head, dark pigmentation, small ears, well furred ears, dark almond shaped eyes, obliquely set. I was impressed on the side profile with the proper shoulder layback, gentle sloping topline, and heavy bone. Upon examination, the feet were large, and of snow shoe type, the coat was a proper double coat, in excellent condition. Moving around the ring, the side gait was effortless, and correct, with good reach and drive, the tail a waving plume. The down and back was clean and unencumbered. This was a very sound Alaskan Malamute, that I considered to be the "complete package", and one that I would be proud to add to a breeding program.

### **Best of Winners: Catera N Chikara's Hershey Kiss (D)**

Very nice well balanced dog. Good head piece, dark pigmentation, dark almond shaped eyes, well furred small ears. On profile, gently sloping topline and proper shoulder layback. Feet were snow shoe type and proper. Very structurally sound, affording the ability to move well on side gait, with excellent reach and drive, with tail carried as a waving plume. The down and back was clean and unencumbered.

### **Best of Opposite: Ch. Kasaan Sno Klassic's Kiss the Fortune (B)**

Lovely, feminine example of the breed. Very nice head, good pigmentation, and almond shaped eyes, small well furred ears. Upon examination, good front assembly, proper shoulder layback, dense coat, moderately bent stifle, and proper snow shoe type feet. The rear was sound with well let down hocks. Movement was effortlessly on side gait, with nice reach on the front and a sound driving rear. The down and back was clean and unencumbered. A lovely bitch overall and one I would be happy to add to a breeding program.

### **Select Dog – GCH Tugar's Taking on Tyson**

Another great example of our breed. Beautifully strong Alaskan Malamute, very nice head piece, dark pigmentation, small ears well furred, almond shaped eyes. Proper shoulder layback, gently sloping topline, proper tail length and carriage. Feet were large and of snow shoe type. This male moved effortlessly around the ring, and I was impressed with the smooth flowing side gait, and an unencumbered clean, down and back. He exhibited nice reach and an exceptionally strong driving rear. Covered ground nicely.

### **Select Bitch – GCH Spiritrun's OHMYGOSH Evvys Here**

Lovely bitch with a beautiful head and expression, lovely profile. Almond shaped eyes, small ears, well furred. On profile, gently sloping topline with proper layback of shoulders. Strong rear with moderately bent stifle, and full extension in the front. The feet were of snow shoe type. This bitch moved very soundly, lovely side gait, and the down and back was clean and unencumbered.

### **Winners Bitch – Adair'N'Hug Fly Me To The Moon**

Beautiful, feminine bitch. This bitch had a lovely head, good pigmentation, almond shaped eyes. On profile, gently sloping topline and moderately bent stifle. Movement around the ring was effortless with proper tail carriage. On examination, good front assembly, nice dense double coat well conditioned. Feet were of snow shoe type. The down and back was clean and unencumbered.

### **Reserve Winners Dog – Oakioks Jack Daniels On The Roc**

Very nice head piece. Good pigmentation, almond shaped eyes. On profile, gently sloping topline, proper shoulder layback, and moderately bent stifle. Feet were of snow shoe type. Structurally sound moving dog with proper reach and drive. The down and back was clean and unencumbered.

### **Reserve Winners Bitch – Mytuk Silent Assassin at Ironpride**

A very lovely young bitch that caught my eye upon entering the ring. An impressive head piece, with well furred small ears and very nice bone. Striking, rich sable color, animated, and seemed to love showing. Light on her feet, exhibited nice movement on side gait, and a clean down and back, she did not put a foot down wrong. The feet were large and of snow shoe type, moderately bent stifle, well let down hocks. The shoulders had proper layback. A very promising young bitch.

The Specials class was challenging and they kept things moving along at a great pace. I would also like to thank the many people who brought their beautiful dogs to show. The Best of Breed ring was very challenging with so many great examples of this breed. Best of Breed, Select Dog, Best of Opposite, Select Bitch, Best of Winners and Winners Dog, Reserve Winners Dog and Reserve Winners Bitch and all the Awards of Merit were all so well presented and all possessed the qualities I look for in an Alaskan Malamute. They were all well within the proper desirable freighting size. They were in excellent condition, heavy boned, with good feet, deep chest and powerful shoulders. All of these dogs looked like they could do their job. They were very sound coming and going and well balanced. Coats were in excellent condition and although there was some trimming it was not so much

that it was objectionable. Temperament was excellent in all of these dogs.

On the negative side, I did see several dogs with undershot bites, snap tails and short tails. There was also some unsound movement.

It was exciting to see so many veterans in such excellent condition. This speaks well for the breed. Thanks again.

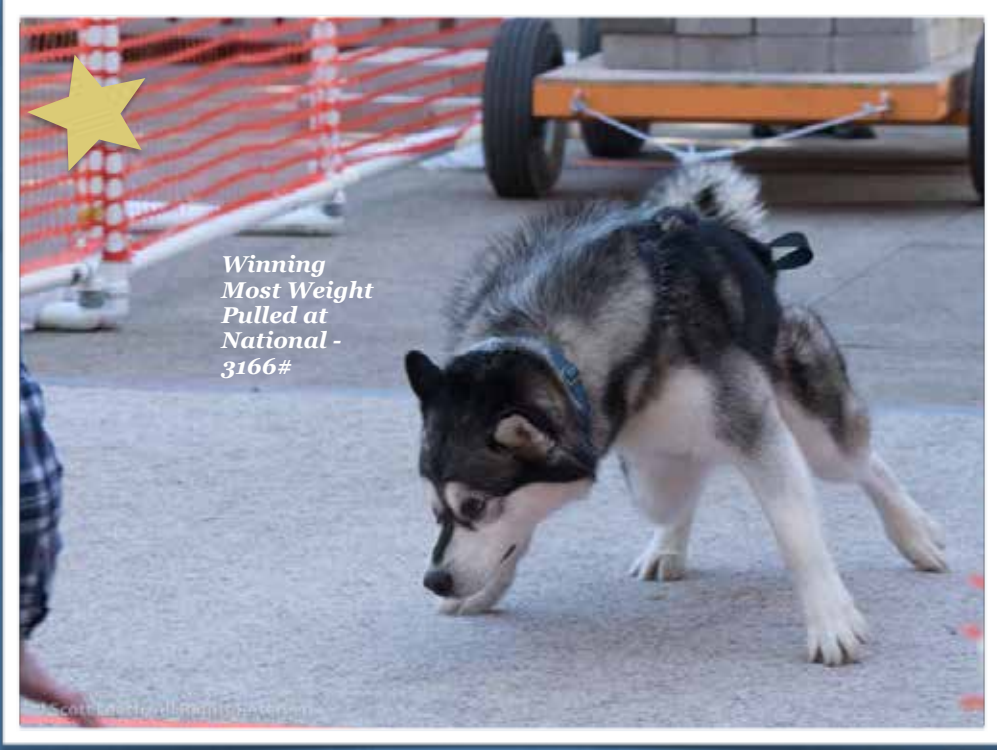

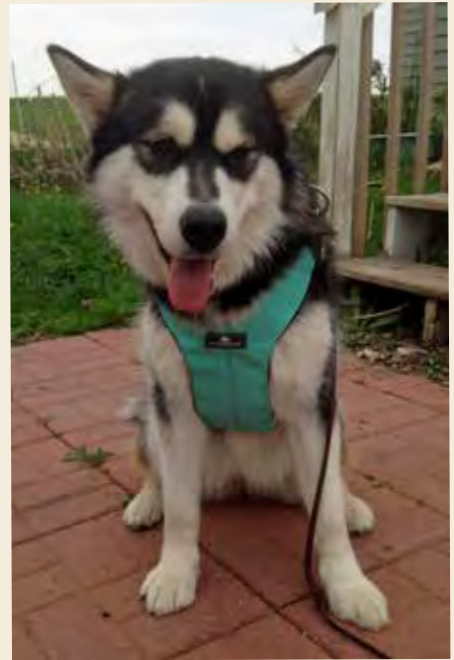
Alexis Smith reviews Dog Seatbelt Harnesses

From the possibility of them becoming projectiles during hard braking or an accident (AAA data shows a 10-pound, unrestrained dog in a car that is traveling only 30 mph will exert 300 pounds of force during a crash); or being deemed a threat to first responders and shot should you need medical attention while in your vehicle; to making a break for that open door during a stop at the gas station, there are plenty of dangers present for a dog that is loose inside a vehicle.

A secured crate is the usual preference for restraining our furry family members, but not every vehicle has space for one. My Dodge Charger, for example, is my preferred mode of transportation, especially for longer drives, but there's just not space for a malamute-sized crate in something that's essentially a muscle car, no matter the number of doors.

Enter the doggy seatbelt harness.

Similar to a walking harness, but generally with padding and/or a wide panel over the dog's breast bone and a heavy ring to snap a tether to (see photos for examples), the seatbelt harness allows your pup to sit in the (preferably rear) seat of your car without giving him/her the opportunity to interfere with your driving or escape out an open door.

There are a couple of different styles of tether that typically come with the harnesses. One style looks

terribly clever in that it clips right into your car's existing seatbelt buckle. I do NOT recommend these. It's too easy for your dog to step on the buckle release and free him/herself. I speak from experience.

The tether style that I prefer is the kind that has a quick link or carabiner on one end for attaching the tether to your seatbelt. You fasten the seatbelt (for three-point belts, I prefer to pull the seatbelt out fully to lock it) and attach the tether to it. Depending on how much room you want to give your pup to move, you can fasten it to either the shoulder or lap belt. If you're setting your pup up in the backseat and don't plan on having anyone sitting with them, snap the seatbelt into the buckle for the far seat. This keeps the release button underneath the seatbelt itself so your pup can't step on it and release the seatbelt. If it's not practical to set it up that way and your dog does release the seatbelt, s/he is at least still secured in your vehicle in some fashion until you have a chance to pull over and correct the issue.

If your harness comes with the buckle-in style tether, it's easy enough to convert it to attach to the seatbelt. Just go to your hardware store and buy a quick link or heavy carabiner (no flimsy keychain ones, please) and loop it through the hole in the tongue of the tether's buckle.

The Ruffwear harness (see photo) has a tether built into the harness that you thread your seatbelt through to secure. Similar suggestions for securing the seatbelt itself apply with this

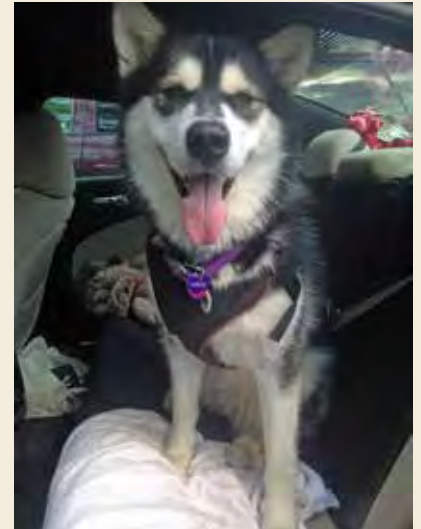
Avoid doggy seatbelts that clip directly into the buckle. It is very easy for your dog to step on the buckle and self-release.

Below: If you use a tether, it can be attached to either the shoulder or lap belt. Be sure to use a heavy duty quick link or carabiner.



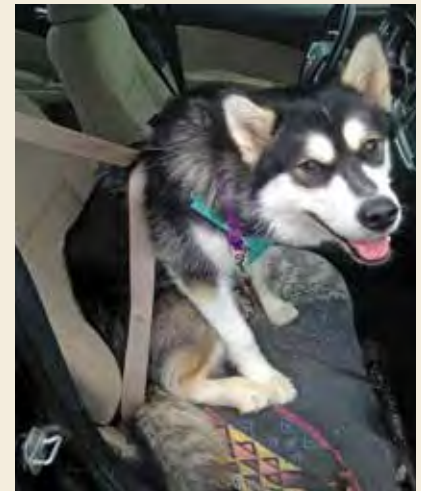
harness as with the regular tether style.

Also, the shorter the tether, the better. The Center for Pet Safety (CPS – [www.centerforpetsafety.org](http://www.centerforpetsafety.org)) recommends not using a harness that uses a tether at all because of the issues with keeping a dog on the seat in an accident when the harness has a tether. Unfortunately, there is only one brand currently that does not utilize the tether design – Sleepypod. In the

Sleepypod, the car seatbelt threads through the harness as though passing through the arm holes of a vest.

The Sleepypod Sport model is rated for dogs weighing up to 90 pounds, and costs about \$90 for the XL (less for smaller sizes). This is the only harness recommended by the CPS.

See the photos for examples of different harness and tether styles.
