Entries must be received by 8:00 pm CST Wednesday, September 18th, 2024, after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is acceptable) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will have the entry cancelled; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature.

Entries received without signature release will be returned.

Entries with email addresses will be acknowledged with an email receipt. CAPER is not responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, and no further efforts will be made. Confirmations and judging schedules will be sent after closing.

Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Show Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show/trial **EXCEPT** that if cancellation is necessary due to COVID-19, entrants will receive full refunds. Refunds will be made, less \$10 per entry, for bitches entered in obedience or rally who come into season after the closing date with presentation of a veterinarian certificate.

Fax/email entries: Entries may be faxed to the Show/Trial Secretary at 262-500-4080, or emailed to secretary@caper-dogs.com. Both the front & back of each entry form must be included, completely filled out and signed, or the entry will not be accepted. Payment can be made via PayPal or credit card by going to www.caper-dogs.com/PayPalCCpayment.htm and following the instructions there. **Payment must include the \$2 per class additional charge to be valid.**

Entry Errors: Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of entries. All entries which include an email address will be sent an entry verification email shortly after receipt. All errors will be corrected prior to closing; exhibitor errors discovered after closing cannot be corrected. Overpayments of less than \$5 per dog will not be refunded.

Transfers to Best of Breed & higher Obedience or Rally classes: Dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for this show may be transferred from the Dog or Bitch class to the Best of Breed class. Obedience & Rally entries can be transferred to the next higher level in the given entered program. Each of these transfer requests must be made to, and accepted by, the Show/Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of any regular judging for the show.

Veteran Dog/Bitch Classes – In accordance with AKC's Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 8: Castrated dogs and spayed bitches may be entered in the Veteran Classes.

Working Dog/Bitch Classes – Open to any dog or bitch holding a Working Dog Certificate issued by AMCA

Awards of Merit (Both Specialties)

Awards of Merit may be awarded to those dogs or bitches NOT winning Best of Breed, Best of Opposite to Best of Breed, Select Dog or Select Bitch, but of such outstanding quality as to deserve honorable mention. Recipients are to be selected at the Judge's discretion and awards given immediately following the awarding of Best of Breed, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. The total number of such awards shall be limited to not more than 25% of the total entry of Specials or to 10 awards, whichever is less.

Best Puppy, Best Bred-by-Exhibitor, Best Veteran and Best Working (National Specialty Only)

First place in each 6-9 and 9-12 class will compete for Best Puppy. If a puppy is Best of Breed or Best of Winners, that puppy will automatically win Best Puppy. Best Bred-by, Best Veteran in each class (8-10, 10-12 & 12+) and Best Working will be chosen in the same manner, from the first-place exhibits in each Bred-by, Veterans and Working Classes.

Points for Reserve Available: At each Regional and National Specialty, the dog designated Reserve Winners Dog and the bitch designated Reserve Winners Bitch will be awarded a three-point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winner's Sex totals at least twice the number required for a five point major, in the region in which the events are held.

Non-Regular Classes (Multiple Dog Entries, National Specialty Only)

Stud Dogs Brood Bitches

Brace

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Class – Dogs/Bitches (may be altered) and are shown with two of their offspring. Owner of Stud Dog/Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of offspring. Class is judged on the merits of the offspring, but the parent will be examined for DQs/excusals. Offspring must be entered in a regular conformation class.

Entry is made for the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch - offspring are not entered on the entry form.

Brace Class – For two Alaskan Malamutes with at least one owner in common. *Both dogs must be entered in another class to qualify for the additional class entry fee.* The two dogs comprising the Brace shall be considered a unit and they must be named at time of entry. If a dog, which is to be part of a brace, is not entered in a regular class, or Best of Breed Competition, the dog must be entered for "Brace Class Only." In making entries for Brace Class Only, full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as a part of a brace, MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for ADDITIONAL CLASSES - "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by the identical owner, the dogs comprising EACH brace must be designated "Brace No. 1", "Brace No. 2", etc. **Please submit Brace entries together.**

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Novice Class – For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who, at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Class – For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who, at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class – For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show and who have won ten (10) first place wins in an Open Class, with competition, to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1-October 31 of the following year. All juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry.

BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on both sides of the entry form.

NOTICE: Juniors with a dog also entered in another class offered at this show who substitute a dog not entered in this show must remit the difference between Junior Only and Junior as an Additional Class entry fee. Juniors who have entered Junior Showmanship only who then substitute another dog will not be charged a further fee.

Requirements

The Futurity and Maturity is open to Alaskan Malamutes who have completed the nomination process in accordance with the rules set forth by AMCA. Eligibility will be verified.

- ▶ All Entrants in the Futurity or Maturity must also be entered in one or more of the regular classes at the regular entry fee.
- ▶ All Entries in the Futurity or Maturity must be made at the same time that the regular class entries are made on an official AKC entry form, with the word "FUTURITY" or "MATURITY" and appropriate AGE CLASS in the space provided for as "Additional Entries".
- ▶ Futurity or Maturity entry fee must be included with the dog's total entry fees, and received by the Superintendent by closing date and time.

Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for all entries as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.

AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

DON'T FORGET TO CHECK THE OWNER-HANDLED BOX ON THE ENTRY FORM IF ENTERING THIS COMPETITION.

All dogs that are owner-handled and are not solely owned or exhibited by professional handlers* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book, and the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner*. Professional handlers, household members and assistants to current professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any breed competition during the entire show.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best Of Breed/Variety and be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled group.

If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.

If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.

If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible winner.

If the regular show Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog who competed in Best of Breed including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as the Best of Breed/Variety for the AKC National AKC Owner-Handled Series.

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay or received payment for handling a dog within the last five years.*

Tournament of Veterans: This event is a competitive event judged by a panel of 3 judges using a point scale. All malamutes at least 8 years of age are invited to participate and compete in their age group, divided by sex. Each entrant will compete only with dogs or bitches within their own age category, with the selection of ONE WINNER PER AGE CLASS. There will NOT be an ULTIMATE WINNER; we feel that each veteran is special and deserves recognition.

Working Dog Showcase: To be eligible for this exhibition, the dog must have a minimum of 2 AMCA working titles, or a working title and 2 legs toward an Advanced title, or a working title and 1 leg toward an Excellent title. Entrants must provide proof of eligibility. Any entrant found to be ineligible will not be allowed to compete, and the entry fee will be forfeited. Spayed bitches and neutered males ARE ELIGIBLE to compete.

Ultimate Alaskan Malamute: This competition recognizes those malamutes who represent the versatile nature of our breed over the course of the National week. Points are earned by placements/achievement in conformation, weight pull, obedience, agility, and/or rally. Dogs MUST be pre-entered in this special competition to participate. To be eligible, they must be entered in at least 3 different sports listed above. Rosettes and themed prizes will be awarded to our 1st through 4th placements. All participants shall receive a certificate of recognition if they receive points in 3 or more qualifying events.

Weight Pull: All events will be held under AMCA Weight Pull Rules. No performance altering drugs may be used on any entrant in competition. A Novice Weight Pull mini-seminar will be conducted immediately prior to this event. This is a non-qualifying pull, 1000# max weight. Novice dogs (at least 1 yr of age) and novice handlers are encouraged to participate in this event. Leashes may be used.

The club will not be responsible for paging anyone if situation deems to be an emergency situation – WE WILL ACT. Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment.
